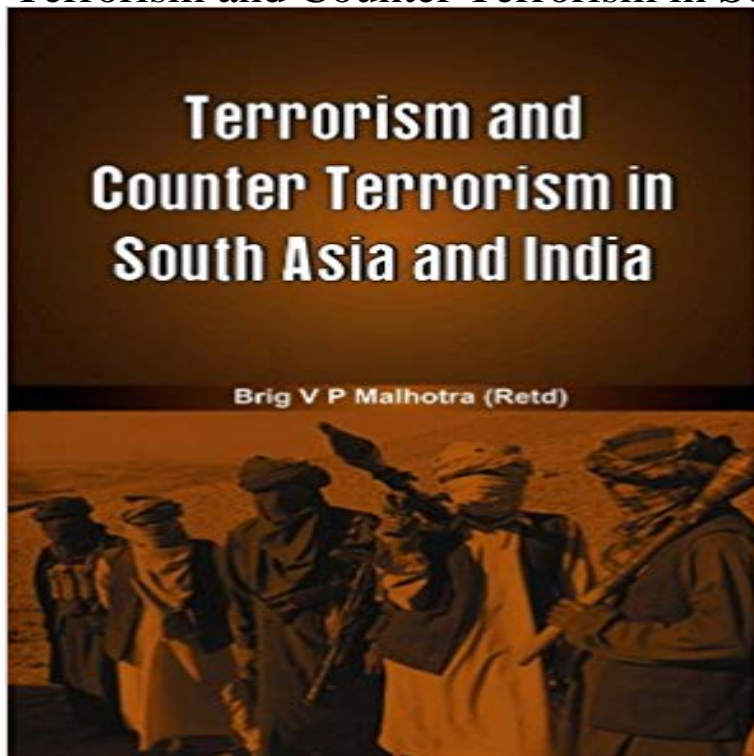


Terrorism and Counter Terrorism in South Asia
