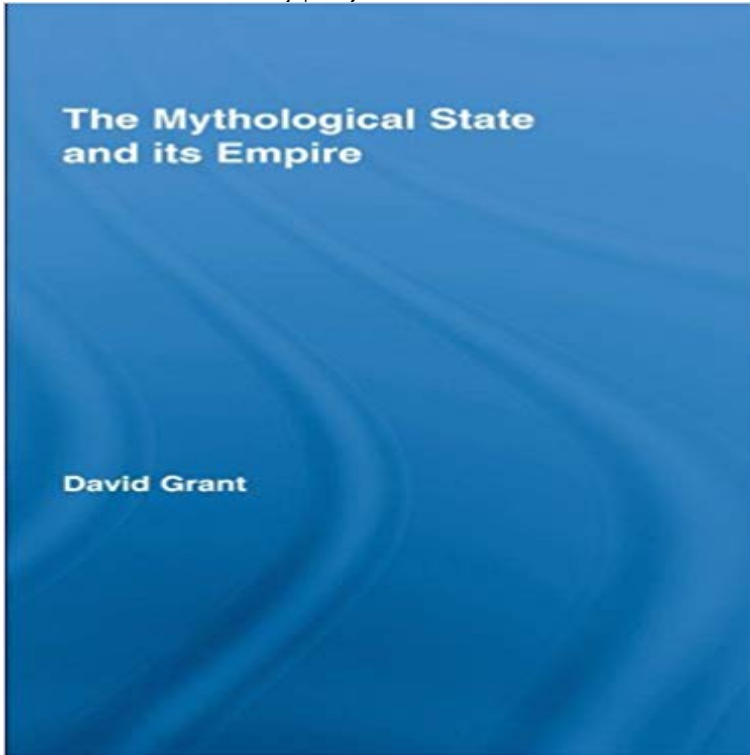


# The Mythological State and its Empire (Routledge Studies in Social and Political Thought)
