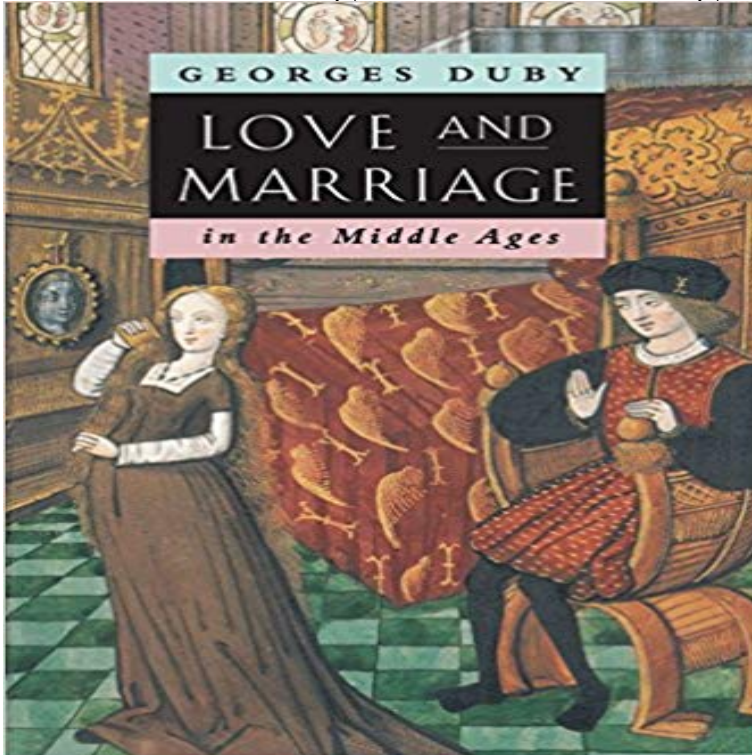


Love and Marriage in the Middle Ages
