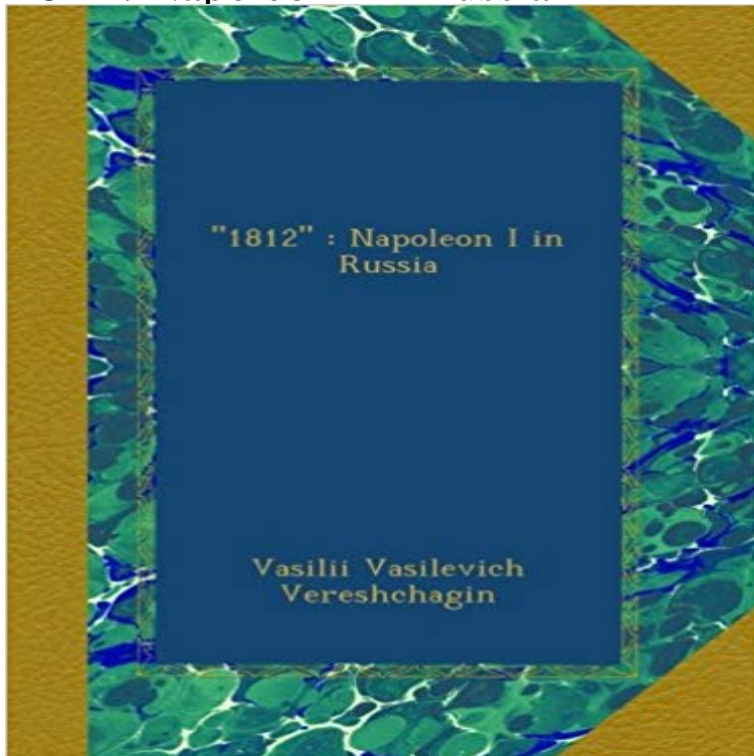


1812 : Napoleon I in Russia
