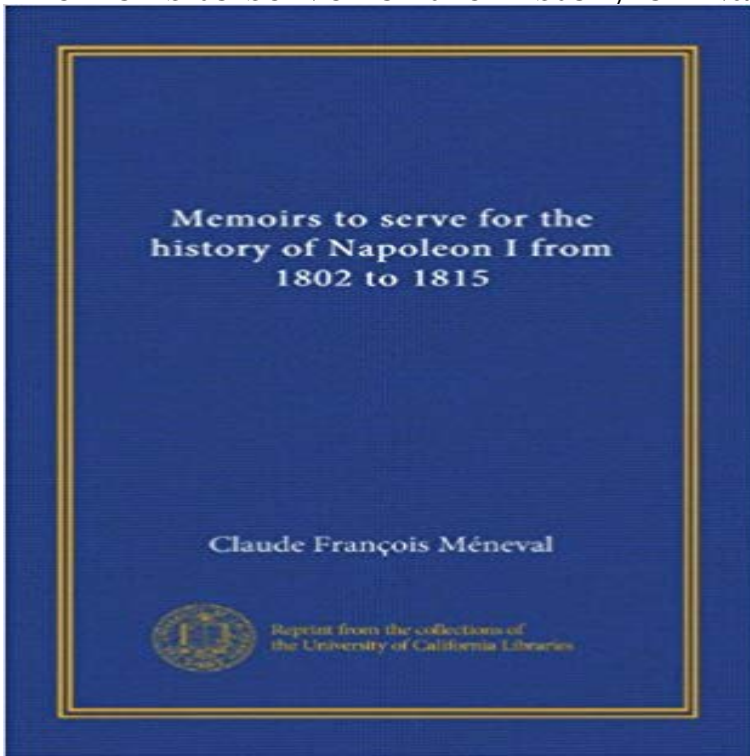


Memoirs to serve for the history of Napoleon I from 1802 to 1815 (v.02)
