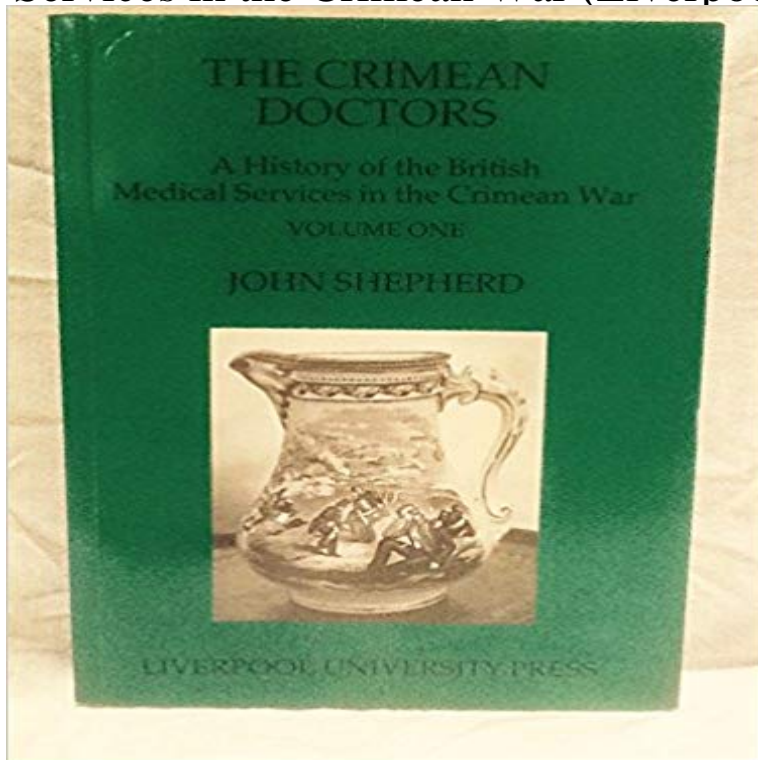


## The Crimean Doctors (2 Volumes): A History of the British Medical Services in the Crimean War (Liverpool historical studies) (Vols 1-2)
