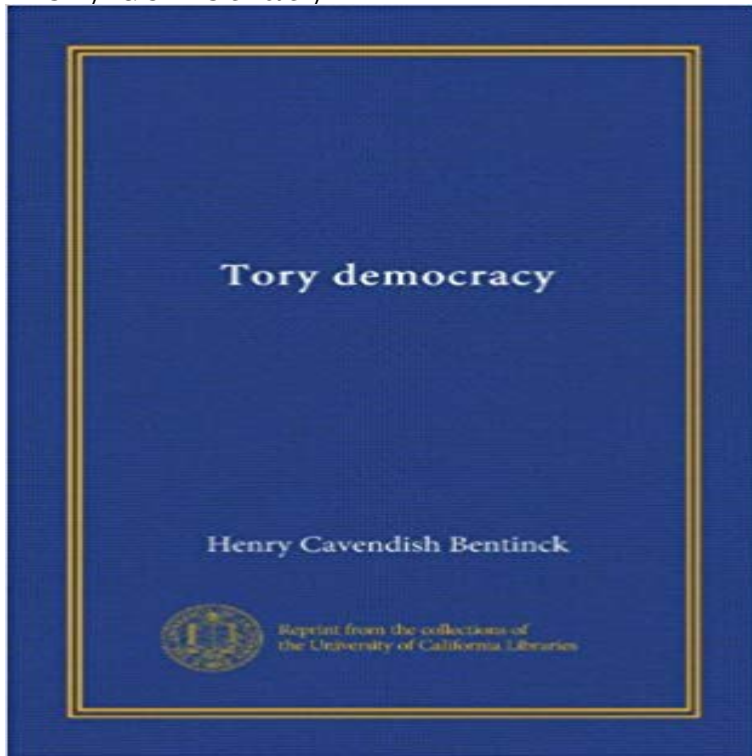


Tory democracy
